- ▶ Complete online application – internationaladmissions.ucdenver.edu
- ▶ \$75 USD application fee
- ▶ Secondary transcripts/mark sheets
- ▶ Transfer applicants need to provide post-secondary transcripts/mark sheets from every post-secondary institution attended
- ▶ Evidence of English language proficiency
- ▶ International Admissions may require additional documents depending upon your individual situation

GRADUATE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- ▶ Complete online application – internationaladmissions.ucdenver.edu
- ▶ \$75 USD application fee
- ▶ Complete post-secondary transcripts/mark sheets with proof of graduation
- ▶ Official GRE/GMAT scores per program requirements
- ▶ Letters of recommendation per program requirements
- ▶ Statement of purpose per program requirements
- ▶ Evidence of English language proficiency
- ▶ Check with your program of interest for any additional requirements



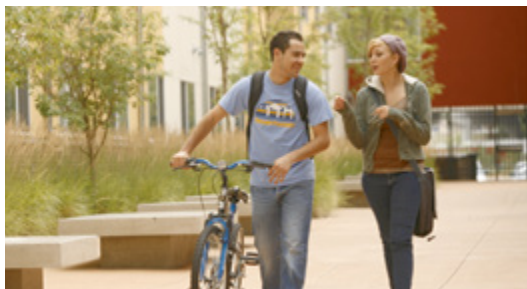
