Dean's Scholarship	Awarded to international students with min 3.5 grade point average. Requires a commitment of three semesters volunteering as an Academic Mentor.	\$22,000 per year on-campus. \$18,000 per year off-campus. Renewable for eight fall/spring semesters of full-time study with 2.75 GPA.
Maryville College Scholarship	Awarded to international students with min 3.0 grade point average.	\$21,000 per year on-campus. \$17,000 per year off-campus. Renewable for eight fall/spring semesters of full-time study with 2.5 GPA.

International Diversity Scholarship	Awarded to first year international students who have a demonstrated record of academic achievement, demonstrated international leadership in the past and have a clear plan for contributing to the international community on campus. Application and phone/skype interview required	FULL-TUITION SCHOLARSHIP. Renewable for eight fall/spring semesters of full-time study with a 3.0 GPA and leadership participation. Must live on-campus
Mountain Challenge Fellowship	First-year student leader who is interested in developing leadership skills while taking part in one of the South's premier outdoor adventure programs. Minimum combined 24+ ACT or 1160+ SAT (Evidence-based reading & writing and Math) score and min 3.0 grade point average. Replaces academic merit scholarship. Application and campus interview required. Fellowship application deadline is Feb 1.	\$24,000 per year Renewable for eight fall/spring semesters of full-time study with 2.75 GPA during first year and 2.85 GPA in second and third year.
