

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The MBA program consists of 10 courses and can be completed in four terms. The program is open to anyone with an undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university. Applicants to the MBA program who do not have a bachelor's degree in business are required to successfully complete the MBA Business Foundation course, MGMT 54201, before taking MBA courses. This online course must be completed before arrival.

ON-CAMPUS WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Graduate assistantships are available on a limited basis to students who prove themselves in their first term at Northwest. Graduate assistantships provide 20 hours of work per week with a stipend and tuiton waiver.

In addition, some student employment opportunities are available campus wide where students may be hired to work up to 20 hours per week and are paid on an hourly basis. These opportunities are more readily accessible to students who have been in attendance for at least one term.
