Transfer scholarships

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits may be eligible for the Transfer Merit Award and the Northwest International Achievement Scholarship if their transferable grade-point average (GPA) is the following:

- 3.00–3.29 transferable GPA: \$1,000 per year
- 3.30–3.49 transferable GPA: \$1,500 per year
- 3.50–4.00 transferable GPA: \$2,500 per year
