

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelors degree from a regionally accredited institution, with a GPA of a 3.0 or higher in the last 60 credit hours
- Resume
- Test score or waiver
 - o Waiver-
 - Undergraduate degree in business with a 3.0 or higher GPA, or
 - 2+ years of professional work experience in logistics and/or supply chain management and an undergraduate degree with a 3.0 or higher GPA
 - Test Score- A GMAT or GRE score may be required if you do not meet the above waiver criteria.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST
